In a digital world, where it is easier to steal a device than it is to steal a physical object, such as a cellphone or a laptop, the problem is even more acute. As reported by USA Today, Sprint, AT&T and T-Mobile have been reported for adopting the practice. And, as per the report, the practice is an unregulated practice in several states.
